## MoANA 2017 SPRING MEETING

### Program Objectives

The Missouri Association of Nurse Anesthetists is dedicated to the presentation of educational programs for CRNAs and anesthesia students to provide updates and review for anesthesia practice. At the conclusion of this meeting, the participant should be able to:

1. Define addiction as a disease as well as the signs, symptoms, and treatment.
2. Review the statistics and the unique occupational hazards that increase the vulnerability of anesthesia providers to chemical dependency.
3. Understand the indiscriminate nature of addiction and recognize maladaptive behaviors.
4. Identify resources available for help for yourself and others if affected by addiction.
5. Describe the incidence of postoperative residual after paralysis and its effect on recovery
6. Explain the importance of monitoring muscle relaxation and reversal.
7. Describe why a reversal medication should often times be given.
8. Describe interventions to reduce perioperative opioid consumption.
9. Identify and discuss non-opioid pharmacologic agents beneficial in the perioperative period.
10. Define ERAS and review data regarding clinical significance.
11. Identify and discuss ERAS interventions and outcomes for orthopedic and abdominal resection.
12. Review guidelines for high risk low occurrence incidents utilizing Human Patient Stimulation.
13. Review procedures for placement of surgical airways using a pig trachea model.
14. Describe use of TEE and identify relevant anatomy for clinical anesthesia practice.
15. Review the State of Anesthesia science through dissemination of research.
16. Review and describe anatomy relevant to regional anesthesia of the upper and lower extremities using live models and ultrasound scanning.
17. Review central line placement and scanning and driving of an ultrasound.
18. Review EKG and CXR interpretation relevant to Nurse Anesthesia Practice.
